Applying for Adult Admission

Applicants who have been out of high school for at least five years and who have earned fewer than 30 semester hours at a college or university may be eligible to attend UNT under Adult Admission.

Eligible individuals may be accepted without the required SAT or ACT test scores only if evidence provided to the admissions office staff suggests the potential of academic success for the individual. Students who are admitted under the provisions of Adult Admission are subject to all other academic requirements of the university.

To be considered for Adult Admission, you must submit:

- An application for admission, which can be completed online at www.applytexas.org
- A non-refundable **\$75** application fee (*after application priority dates, application fee is subject to change*)
- An official high school transcript
- Official transcripts from any previous college/university (students who are transferring fewer than 30 hours from another college/university must also have a minimum 2.50 grade-point-average, 4.0 grading system, and be eligible to return to any institutions attended.)
- Personal statement concerning your academic preparedness for university level study, your intended major, career goals, and any other information you feel is pertinent to the individual review of your application.
